Things to Know

Okinawa, the principal island of Okinawa Prefecture's 160 or so islands, is often referred to as the "Keystone of the Pacific" because of its strategic location relative to major Far East cities. Kadena is located about 900 miles from Tokyo, Manila, Seoul and Hong Kong, and about 1,200 miles west of Guam. The island is 67 miles long and varies from 2-17 miles wide. The climate compares to U.S. southeastern coastal areas, making it perfect for those who enjoy swimming, snorkeling, scuba diving, golfing, boating and taking part in other recreational activities.

Temperatures range from the mid-90s to high-40s and humidity is relatively high throughout the year. With the heat and high humidity, mold and mildew can be a problem. Plan accordingly when packing goods to be shipped to Okinawa and be prepared to deal with the moist climate when you arrive.

With our normally warm, sunny climate, you will have an opportunity to trek the miles of sandy beaches, enjoy local attractions and visit neighboring islands. Since Okinawa is in "Typhoon Alley," high winds and rain periodically affect the island between July and November. In May, the island usually experiences its rainy season, which lasts about 30 days.

Driving – Must be 18 years of age to drive off base. 16 yr. olds can obtain a driver's license to drive on Kadena AB. Contact Schilling Community Center for the most up to date info on how to obtain a driver's license if you don't have a stateside license. Okinawans drive on the left side of the road. Most new arrivals find the change takes some getting used to; however, you will quickly master it. Pedestrians must also adjust and should look to the right before stepping off a curb. You also will have to learn the international road signs and know Japanese road signs.

Jobs - Must be at least 16 years old for employment, some positions require 18. The Human Resource office is located in building 723, phone number 634-2330. Jobs are also posted on the website https://www.usajobs.gov/

Volunteering – Youth Programs are always in need of volunteers for sports and programs to include numerous community service events.

Curfew – Applies to all persons under the age of 18 must be in quarters or with parent/designated adult during restriction times.

Off Base - Within Okinawa Prefecture: 2200-0400 Sunday through Saturday On Base - 2200-0530 weekdays (Sunday night through Thursday morning) 2400-0530 weekends and holidays (Friday morning through Sunday morning or from the evening preceding a holiday through the morning of that holiday)


